Scripting – 18 Classes

This module focuses on developing strong writing skills required for media anchoring. Students learn how to write news scripts, show intros, links, interview questions, event scripts, story-based segments, and on-air delivery formats. The training helps in building clarity, structure, flow, and impactful content creation for television, radio, and digital platforms.

Cubase – 15 Classes

Cubase is a professional audio production software used for recording, editing, mixing, and mastering voice-overs. In these classes, students learn mic setup, voice recording techniques, noise cleaning, EQ, compression, sound effects usage, multitrack editing, and final audio export. The module prepares learners to produce broadcast-quality audio for anchoring and voice-based projects.

Announcer / Compère – 18 Classes

This module trains students for live stage anchoring, studio presentation, and event hosting. The training covers voice modulation, diction, body language, camera presence, confidence building, live audience handling, timing control, show opening/closing techniques, and professional compère delivery skills. It prepares students for TV anchoring, radio announcing, stage shows, and professional hosting assignments.
